Companies organising a Satellite Symposium related to the ESPEN attendees outside the official booking process and platform could encounter serious disagreements with the Central ESPEN Authorities.

No data should be presented in any satellite symposium which will subsequently be presented either orally or as a poster at the meeting.

PROGRAMME AND SPEAKERS

To have their satellite symposium programme approved by the ESPEN Scientific Committee, companies holding an official satellite symposium programme during ESPEN 2020 are requested to provide the organizers with the following information regarding their symposia:

- Preferred recording option
- o Title of the satellite symposium
- o Speakers names and complete details
- o Title of each presentation given during the symposium

RECORDING OPTIONS

PRE-RECORDED

option 1: handle the recording yourself or through a third-party agency and send us the final video file to be uploaded on the ESPEN platform.

option 2: use the ESPEN platform to have your speakers record their presentations (see further details on this option further below)

LIVE

Option 1: fully live symposium (no pre-recorded elements). You will use the ESPEN platform to live stream your symposium (further information on this option below)

Option 2: pre-recorded presentations with live Q&A and/or polling - handle the recording yourself or through a third-party agency and send us the final video file to be uploaded on the ESPEN platform

Option 3: pre-recorded presentations with live Q&A and/or polling - use the ESPEN platform to have your speakers record their presentations (see further details on this option further below)



YOU WISH TO USE THE ESPEN PLATFORM

We encourage you to use the ESPEN platform for your recordings, as this comes at no additional cost and will ensure proper uniformity across the presentations of your session.

TO PRE-RECORD YOUR PRESENTATIONS

Whether you have a live symposium or a pre-recorded one, you may chose to use the ESPEN platform to handle the recording of your speakers' presentations.

In this scenario, you will need to communicate the detailed programme of your symposium to Corentin.ruy@mci-group.com via the symposium programme form. Your programme will then be uploaded to the platform and we will send you the login details for each speaker for the platform, as well as the detailed guidelines on "how to record your presentation", so that you may provide your speakers with all the relevant information.

TO LIVE STREAM YOUR SESSION

If you intend to hold your session "fully live", with no pre-recording, you will need to communicate the detailed programme of your symposium to Corentin.ruy@mci-group.com via the symposium programme form. Your programme will then be uploaded to the platform and we will send you the login details for each speaker for the platform, along with the relevant quidelines for them to upload their slides in the platform in due time.

Further information and training will be provided later on regarding the live streaming of the session (speaker virtual green room, moderator access, etc).
