### FOREWORD

Thank you for agreeing to be a speaker/presenter at ESPEN 2026 Congress.

By agreeing to this, you hereby consent to ESPEN the use of your name, photograph, image, presentation, or portions quoted or derived from your presentation in the publication, advertising or promotion of this event and to grant a non-exclusive right to broadcast, record and re-use the content.

You also understand that the event in its entirety and/or portions thereof may be published via the event's website, podcasts, webinars, and other printed or electronic media for promotional purposes of the event and by signing below, you are consenting to all such derivative uses.

### AGREEMENT

#### ARTICLE 1: PURPOSE

#### ARTICLE 3: EXPLOITATION OF THE MATERIAL

The availability period during which the recordings will be made available by ESPEN during the time outlined in Article 1.

#### ARTICLE 4: SUB-TRANSFER

ESPEN can mandate any third party of its choice to execute the acquired rights related to the copy, storage, reproduction and representation of the material. Any sub transfer will be ruled by a document of understanding between ESPEN and the third party, including the terms of this agreement as a minimum standard.

#### ARTICLE 5: OBLIGATION OF ENTITY

ESPEN will indicate the name of the AUTHOR and the title of the presentation(s), as well as the date and event of the original presentation.

#### ARTICLE 6: PRESENTER REMUNERATION
